## **RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN MMMSCHOOL AND OTHER THREE BRANCHES: Christian Sharing !**

Thank you very much for your meetings and activities of raising financial assistance for Micindo Mistelbach Millennium School and her branches. We are very grateful.

MMM School is the original place and Main Campus located in Kamwenge District, Fort Portal Diocese, where I am incardinated. Moved by the miserable state of lack of schools in our area, I motivated the neighboring villages to start an educational facility for our children in 2000. We called it Micindo Mistelbach Millennium School. This is in West Uganda. At that time we were being helped by friends in Austria.

The Uganda Episcopal Conference, appointed me to teach in Uganda Martyrs' National Major Seminary, Alokolum. I have stayed here for thirty (30) years. In these three decades, I have met people of God in areas and villages worse than my home, Micindo, where I originate. I was moved with pity to help the children of God in knowing at least how to read and write. So in 2016 – 2017, when I was in my sabbatical leave at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Catholic Church, Aboite Center Road, Fort Wayne, I encouraged the people in three hard to reach districts to begin Nursery Schools. These are:-

1. Queen of Peace and Holy Trinity School, Nanda, in Kiryandongo District, located in Hoima Catholic Diocese. This took off well. It has grown to Primary Seven (7). But it still has challenges of infrastructure and getting qualified teachers.
2. Mulago Holy Trinity Community School in Oyam District, located in Lira Catholic Diocese. This has a lot of challenges; namely, poor mind-set of parents, lack of classrooms and qualified teachers. It is struggling to begin Primary Five (5).

3. Canokela Holy Trinity Community School in Nwoya District, located in the Archdiocese of Gulu. This is in the worst situation. The small school we stated in 2017, was destroyed by greedy land grubbers in the government claiming that the land was theirs. The case is in courts of law. However, the district leaders permitted us to go back and rebuild. We have not done much here except the teachers' house we completed this year. The children are still in structures of mud and wattle thatched by grass.

I take these as branches of Micindo Mistelbach Millennium School which share on the donations sent to the Mother School. The donations help in constructions and teachers' salaries which are very humble! These branches were begun with the same intention and compassion like MMM School. Some of the donations are spent on the needy students for paying their tuition/school-fees. I am doing this from the inspiration of the virtue of charity or Christian sharing. There are many places in Uganda now worse than Micindo Mistelbach Millennium School! We are working on the Holy Trinity Teachers' Community. This is a group of Catholic Women and Men who will devotedly serve in deprived areas. They will teach the children in the underprivileged communities of Uganda and beyond. They will give the children a meaningful, liberating and holistic education. These shall be Women and Men able to lay down their lives for these underprivileged children as they teach them about God and the whole creation. May the Triune God help them to bear enduring fruit amidst His disadvantaged population. This team of Holy Trinity Teachers Community, will be the ones running these four school as a starting point of their mission.

I wish all the children of Uganda and beyond could have an opportunity of going to school. But if the donors say, I should stop spending their money on the other branches and concentrate on MMM School only, I will obey. I will follow their command. After all, the three sections of MMM School still need financial assistance in plastering unfinished classrooms, in constructing more dormitories of students and teachers' houses, in paying teachers not on government payroll..... e.t.c. e.t.c. Our needs shall take a very long time to be resolved. But as Children of God, even if still needy in one place, we noticed that some others are more needy than the original place. This is why, moved by the Gospel Charity, we included these young Nursery and Primary Schools in the greater picture of MMM School.

If my explanation is not satisfactory, please do not hesitate to ask more question. I promise to follow what you will finally decide with our donors, friends and well-wishers.

Lastly, I have booked a visa interview with the American Embassy in Kampala, Uganda, on August 5, 2025. This was the earliest slot available. After that interview, I will inform you whether I have been allowed to come to Fort Wayne to pay you a visit. It will be my joy to see you again, explain more and answer more questions. In that case, I could come around Christmas 2025, July-August 2026 and probably June-July 2027.

May God protect us and bless the works of our hands and intellect!
